2018 BIOMETRIC SCREENING TEST ADD-ONS

As part of this year's health screenings, medical plan members have the option of getting additional tests run from their blood draw. Employees/Spouses will pay for these tests (out of pocket) on the day of the biometric screening event.

C-Reactive Protein (CRP)	Measures general levels of inflammation in the body and is done to help determine if there is an increased chance of having a sudden heart problem.	\$20
Thyroid (TSH)	Helps to check for thyroid gland problems.	\$15
Prostate Specific Antigen (PSA) (Men Only)	This test is used to help screen for prostate cancer. It is important to speak with your physician about the meaning of your PSA results.	\$15
Hemoglobin A1c	Reflects the average blood sugar level for the past two to three months, and is used to determine if diabetes may be present due to increased glucose levels.	\$15
Homocysteine	Reflects naturally occuring amino acid found in blood plasma. High levels could increase the chance of heart disease, stroke, Alzheimer's disease, and osteoporosis.	\$40

Vitamin D	Test levels of Vitamin D in your system.	\$40
Vitamin B12	Test levels of Vitamin B12 in your system.	\$40
