

## Horsetooth Reservoir County Park

- ◆ Elevation of 5,430 feet
- ◆ Open year-round with 2,040 acres of water and 1,900 acres of public lands
- ◆ 6.5 miles long, 212 feet deep at deepest point
- ◆ Fishing, boating, camping, picnicking, swimming, water-skiing, rock climbing
- ◆ Great fishing: walleye, smallmouth bass, trout and other species
- ◆ 7 waterfront cabins available year-round
- ◆ Full-service marina: (970) 223-0140

## Regulations to Help Us Serve You

- ◆ Quiet hours are 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
  - ◆ Alcohol is only allowed in campsites and on boats. No alcohol in day use areas.
  - ◆ Pets must be leashed at all times (10 ft. max.) and must not be left unattended.
  - ◆ Camping is in designated campsites only.
  - ◆ Homeland Security prohibits recreation on dams. Stay 100 feet away from dams when on land - no restrictions from water.

# Entrance Permits

- ◆ Required of all visitors at all times
- ◆ Annual Entrance Permits - valid for a year from month of purchase, transferable among vehicles registered to the same household. Buy at entrance stations, nearby retail outlets or online. For a list of where you can purchase each permit, or to buy certain permits online, visit:

## Vehicle (includes non-trailer watercraft)

Larimer County resident:	\$90
Non-resident:	\$120
Senior:	\$65
Disabled:	\$10
Veteran resident:	\$65
Bison Permit (low income):	\$45

## Combo (vehicle + trailer watercraft)

Larimer County resident:	\$180
Non-resident:	\$240
Senior:	\$140
Disabled:	\$105

(slipped and moored marina customers must purchase combo permit)

- ◆ Daily Entrance Permits - valid day of purchase until noon the next day. Buy at entrance stations and self-serve stations.  
\$9/vehicle  
\$9/boat trailer only  
\$18/vehicle + boat trailer

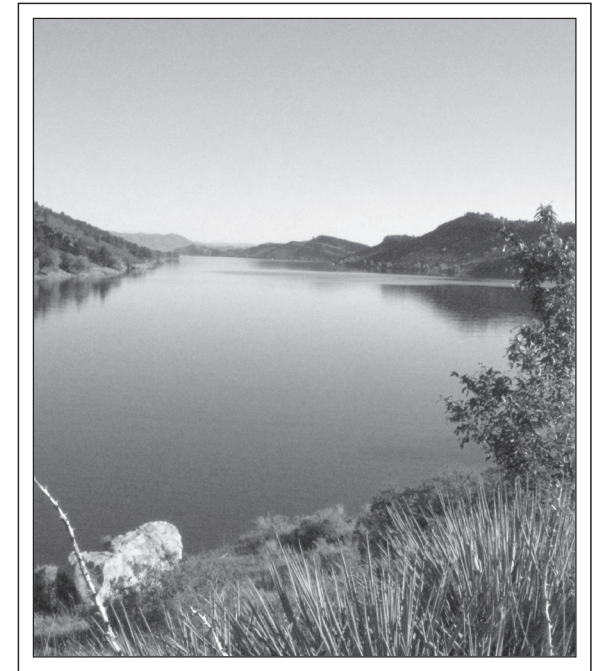
