REAL PROPERTY PROTEST PROCEDURES

Real Property protests will be accepted from May 1, 2021 through June 1, 2021.

All property owners may protest. Owners should note that submitting a protest initiates a review of the property value and may result in a higher valuation if warranted. We cannot accept appeals sent in by email or taken over the phone.

An **ONLINE PROTEST** typically takes less than fifteen minutes and includes an email confirmation that ensures it was submitted prior to the deadline.

PROTESTS OVER THE PHONE:

If you choose to present oral objections to the Assessor during a phone conference, you may elect to complete this protest form and deliver it to the Assessor's office at the address above. To preserve your right to protest, you must complete your schedule phone conference on or before June 1, 2021.

OR

PROTESTS BY MAIL: If you choose to mail a written protest, you may elect to complete this protest form and mail it to the Assessor at the address above. **To preserve your right to protest, your mailed protest must be postmarked no later than June 1, 2021.**
