If you send your request by USPS or by email, a date and time will be assigned to you. We are not able to schedule hearings by requests made by phone or fax. Due to statutory deadlines, hearings cannot be rescheduled. If you fail to appear for any reason, the hearing will proceed, a decision will be made, and you will be notified of further appeal options.

<u>Personal Property</u> (furnishings, machinery, office equipment, etc.) **must be postmarked by the USPS, dated and time stamped using email, or delivered in person to our office by 5:00 p.m. on July 20, 2018.**

Hearing Notices will include the date, time, and location of your hearing and will be delivered according to the method you submitted the documents:

USPS – Notice will be mailed to the address on the NOD. Please provide an alternate address if you do not want the notice mailed to the address on your NOD.

Email – Notices will be electronically mailed using the originating email address.

In Person – Notice will be provided to you at the time of delivery of the documents to our office.
