**V.A.L.E. SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT**  
**04/01/2017 – 12/31/2017**

**INFORMATION**

The 8<sup>th</sup> Judicial District V.A.L.E. Board will make available scholarship awards for victim services conferences or trainings. Current V.A.L.E. grant recipients are eligible to apply for a scholarship up to \$500.00 for conference/training registration fees and/or lodging expenses. Awards are based on availability of V.A.L.E. funds and will not exceed a total of \$10,000.00.

**APPLICATION**

Grantees who wish to apply for a scholarship must submit an application on the V.A.L.E. Board Scholarship Application. Applications can be obtained online at <http://www.larimer.org/da/vicwit/vale.htm>. Applications should be submitted via email to Sunni Ward, V.A.L.E. Administrator at [Wardsd@co.larimer.co.us](mailto:Wardsd@co.larimer.co.us). Grantees must attach to or include with the application a copy of the conference/training brochure.

**DEADLINES**

The scholarship award period is April 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017. Grantees can submit an application anytime during this period. Applications must be submitted no later than 60 days prior to the conference/training registration deadline.

**REQUIREMENTS**

Scholarship awards can only be made for in-state victim service related conferences/trainings. Awards can only be used for registration fees and/or lodging expenses. The training must have a direct victim emphasis. Within 30 days following the conference/training, scholarship recipients are required to submit a certificate of attendance. Recipients who fail to submit this documentation could risk future funding opportunities.
