Community Goal: All children's healthy development (including social-emotional) is optimized by a coordinated system that supports

- Informed parents/caregivers
- Universal standardized developmental screening
- Effective referrals

Developmental Monitoring

An informal process of close and continuous observation of a child's development in order to identify risk for developmental delay

Partners: Primary care providers, Department of Human Services caseworkers, home visitation providers, and early care and learning (school districts and community providers)

Screening

The use of a standardized developmental screening tool to identify children with (or at risk for) developmental delay for the purpose of referring to appropriate services

Partners: Primary care providers, home visitation providers, Early Intervention at Foothills Gateway, school district preschool programs and Child Find

All community partners may make referrals if they have a concern about a child's development and/or social-emotional well-being.

Referral

Request developmental evaluation, services or supports for a child or family

Evaluation

A formal process used to determine a child's need and/or eligibility for developmental supports and services

Support and Services

Connect families to resources necessary for their overall health and wellbeing
