

Sanitizer Concentration Log

Concentrations of sanitizers:

- Chlorine: 50-200 parts per million (ppm).
- Quaternary ammonium: 200 - 400 ppm.
- Iodine: 12.5 – 25 ppm.

Sanitizer concentration should be checked once every shift for warewashing machines and every fill for sanitizer buckets.

Sanitizer sources:

- Dishmachine
- Sanitizer buckets
- 3-compartment warewashing sinks

A manager will verify that sanitizer concentrations are being checked.
