# MOU

Memorandum of understanding (MOU). The county and the applicant shall execute a memorandum of understanding, prior to engaging in the process of forming an intergovernmental agreement, the purpose of which is:

- a. To acknowledge the intent of the parties to begin joint discussions which may result in the approval of an intergovernmental agreement.
- b. b. Establish the timeframe for those discussions and any significant milestones agreed upon.
- c. c. Establish the timeframe for review, public input and public hearing before the county commissioners.

# IGA

Upon request of the State of Colorado or a political subdivision of the state proposing to engage in an area or activity of state interest, the requirements of this [section 14](#) may be met by the approval of an intergovernmental agreement between the county and such applicant.

The county commissioners may, but shall be under no obligation to do so, approve such an intergovernmental agreement in lieu of a permit application and review as provided by this section.

# IGA

No 1041 permit application to conduct the activity or area of state interest shall be required, provided that all of the following conditions are met.

1. The state or political subdivision applicant and the county must both be authorized to enter into such an agreement.
2. The purpose and intent of this section 14 must be satisfied by the terms of the agreement.
3. A public hearing must be conducted by the county commissioners..
