Thornton's written rebuttal submitted today cites my recent concerns regarding their apparent non-compliance with Colorado Revised Statutes, Title 37, Article 86, Rights-of-Way and Ditches (§ 37-86-102, 103, 105, 106), claiming, "Larimer County's 1041 criteria for the siting and design of a pipeline project do not address the applicability of these statutes to a project subject to a 1041 permit. ...whether these statutes are applicable or not, they should not be considered under this 1041 process".

Thornton directs the Commissioners to put on blinders and ignore issues of non-compliance with CO Statutes in determining if their latest proposal is a **reasonable** alternative.

Thornton expects the Commissioners to assume a tremendous liability in directing them to ignore the hierarchy of laws and the CO statutes that protect the citizens of Larimer County.
