# Does NISP Benefit Larimer County?

- We get a **7%** share of the water
- But we take nearly all of the negative impact from infrastructure development:
  - A reservoir that is questionably sited and of dubious recreational utility
  - An egregious environmental impact:
    - Lifting the water from the river into the reservoir at an enormous electricity cost
    - Relocation of Highway 287 (disruption and questionable routing)
  - Pipeline construction and associated eminent domain actions that will severely degrade the property rights (and property values) of **Larimer County** residents

# Whom Do You Represent?

- When the city of Thornton wanted to build a pipeline that offered negligible benefits to **Larimer County** residents, you voted **NO**.
- Now **NISP** wants to drop an undesirable water storage facility and about the same amount of pipeline onto **Larimer County** residents with negligible benefits.
- How could you say **NO** to Thornton then and now say **YES** to **NISP**?
- You do not represent Weld, Boulder or Morgan counties.
- You represent **Larimer County**.
- NISP is no good for **Larimer County**. **JUST SAY NO**.
