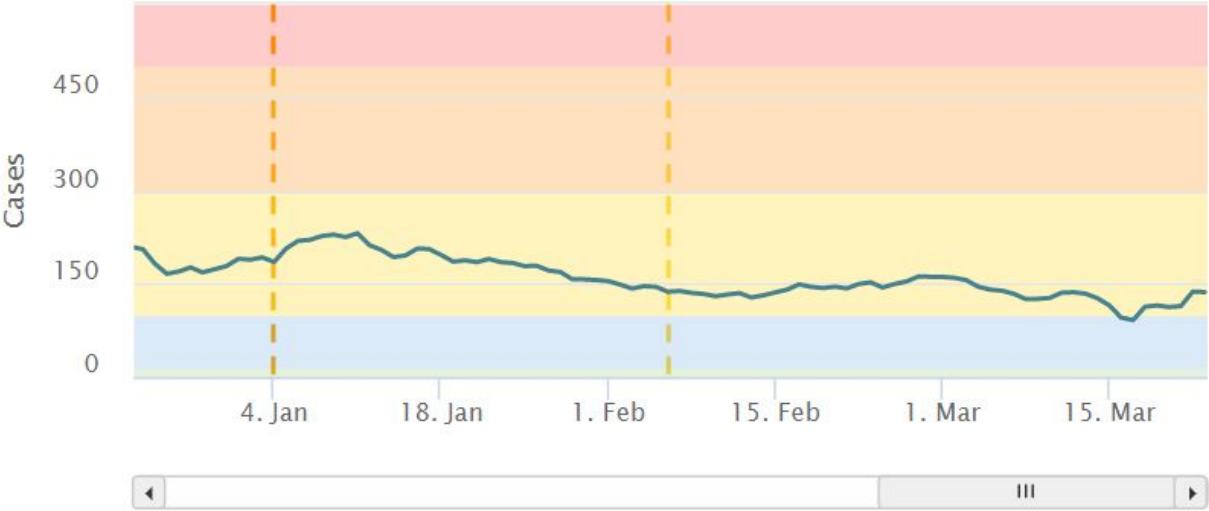


COVID-19 Dashboard

Cases/100k: 7-Day Rate



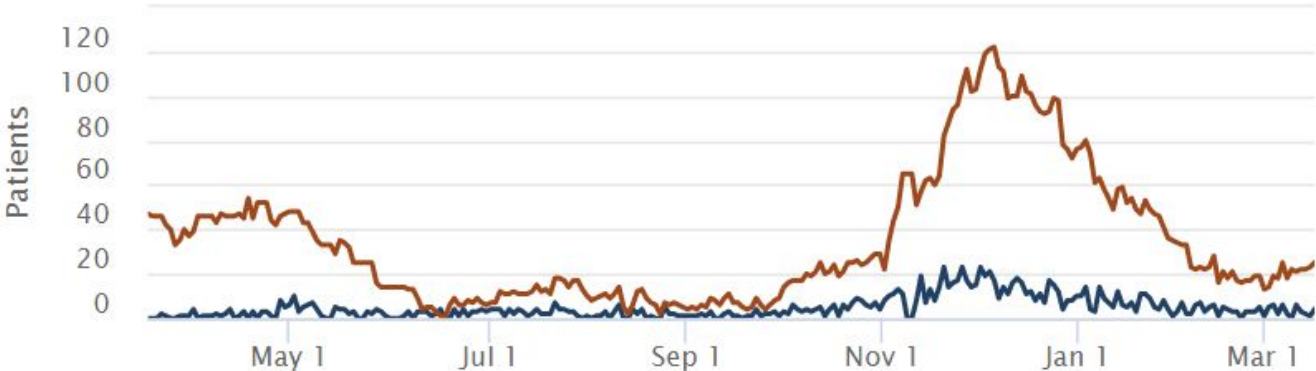

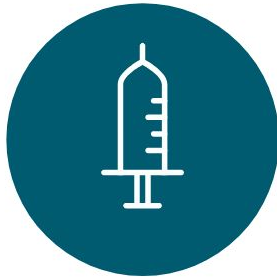
The state moved from 14- to 7-day as a dial determinate on Feb. 5, 2021.

Total Hospitalized COVID-19 Positive Patients and Patients Admitted by Day

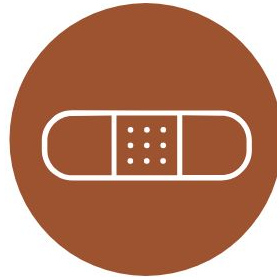

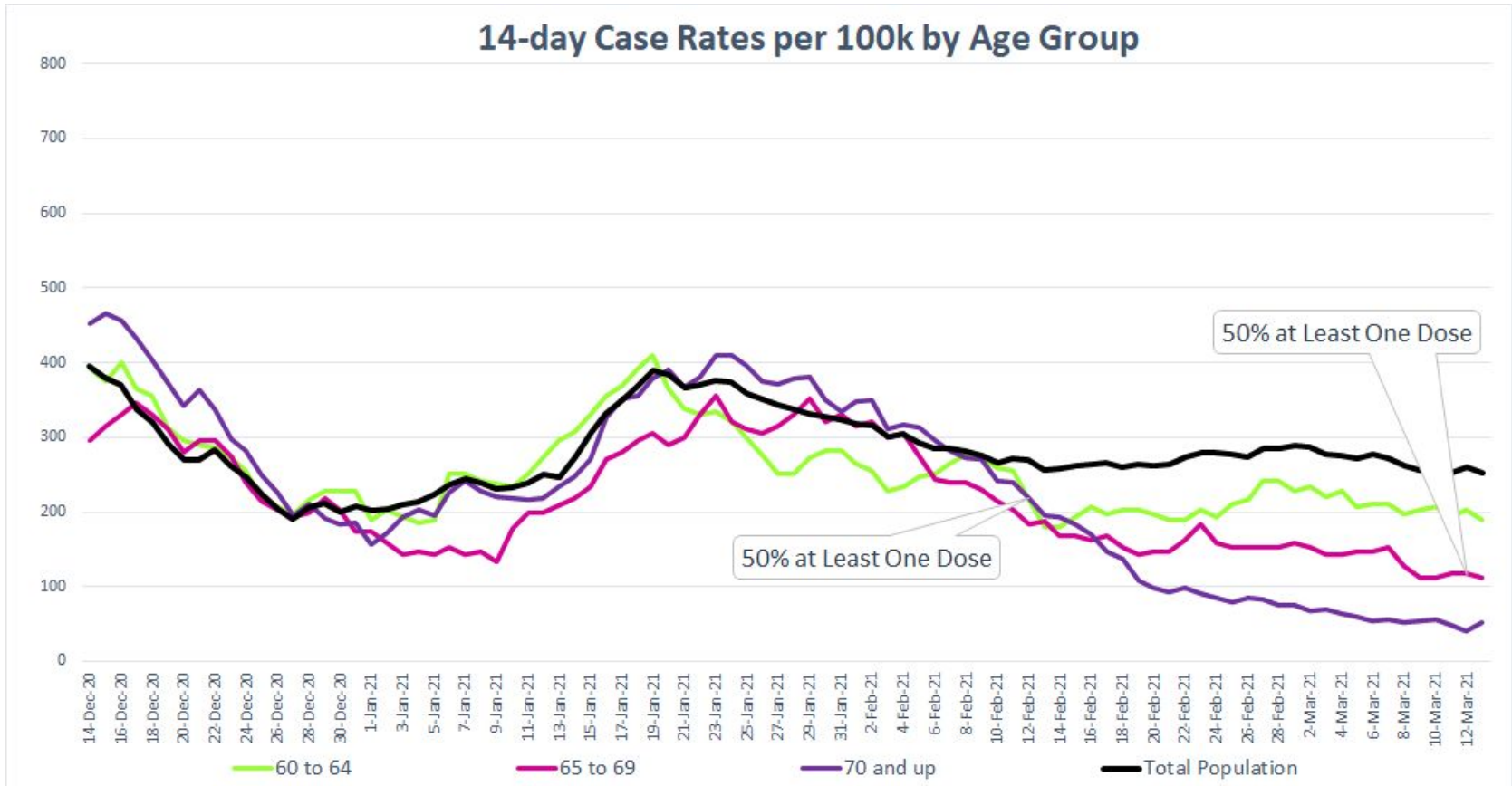

Declines in Case Rate Among Older Adults

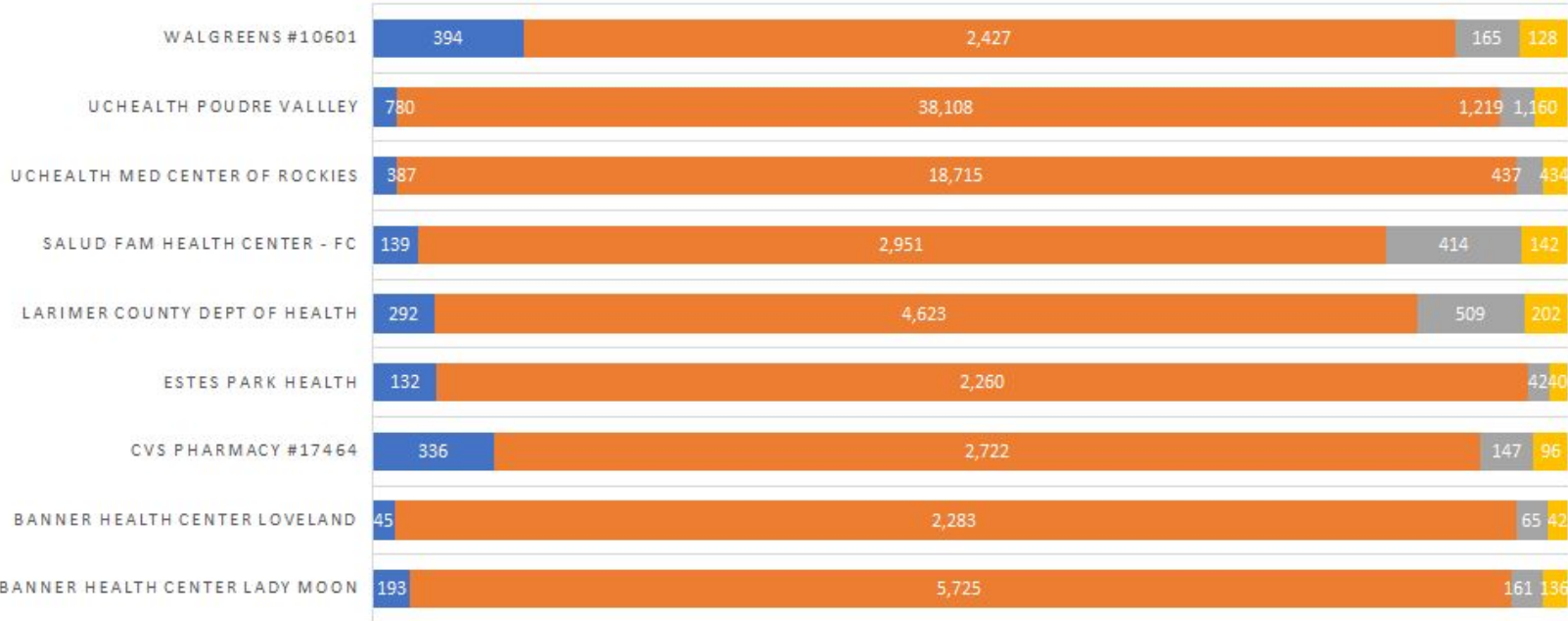
