How can I register for the Virtual Open House through Zoom?

How can I view the floodplain on my property?

You may view floodplain information for your property using the Colorado Hazard Mapping and Risk Portal (CHAMP). To use CHAMP, visit <u>www.coloradohazardmapping.com</u> and follow the steps below:

- 1. Select the box on the left side of the screen that is labeled "Flood Hazard".
- 2. On the screen that appears, enter your address in the box at the top of the screen labeled "Homeowner" and click the "Generate Report" button on the right side of the screen. The website will generate maps of the current and new floodplain for your property. This process may take a few minutes.
- 3. Click the "Aerial" button at the top left of the map window to see the aerial imagery for your property. Zoom in and out using the "+" and "-" buttons on the top left of the map windows.

How can I view the Flood Insurance Study (FIS) and Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM)?

To view the preliminary FIS and FIRM documents, please visit the Larimer County Floodplains website at <u>www.larimer.org/engineering/floodplain</u> or contact Devin Traff to make an appointment and view the documents in-person.
